What is a Neighbourhood Plan?

It is a statutory document that will cover Kirkby Malzeard, Laverton and Dallowgill and once it is in place all Planning Applications in the Parish will have to comply with this Plan as well as with the Harrogate Council Local Plan and the National Planning Policy Framework.

It will give our local community more control over the type of development which takes place here, so that our Parish remains an area where we are all happy to live and work.

How will the Plan be prepared?

The Parish Council has formed a Steering Group comprising Councillors and residents to undertake this task.

This Steering Group will carry out a comprehensive **consultation programme** both to obtain data about the Parish and also to find out what measures you feel the Plan should contain.

How will I be involved in the consultation?

To begin with during Autumn 2019 there will be opportunities to provide your initial views at village events such as this. **Please help by completing and returning the short questionnaire on the reverse of this update.**

Then in early 2020, members of the Steering Group will be consulting formally with all individuals who live and work here and also talking separately to employers, businesses, local organisations and any other group who might be able to provide a useful input.
